MicroEntrepreneur Operating Capital Program



May be used for operating capital expenses specific to the business including but not limited to: rent or lease, utilities, payroll, and inventory. There are a total of seven loans up to \$15,000 available currently, 60-month term with a 5% interest rate. The loan will be secured by personal guarantee of any and all principals or interests of business who have 20% or more ownership. All applicants must have an existing business within the Pottsville corporate city limits and all local, state, and federal taxes must be current. All applicants must be microentrepreneurial in that they have 10 or less full-time equivalent employees





Current Programs

The Pottsville Area Development
Corporation exists to promote the
economic community and aesthetic
development of Downtown Pottsville and
Pottsville's Designated Enterprise Zone.
Initial start-up funds were provided by the
City of Pottsville under the
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the
Pennsylvania Enterprise Zone Program.
Capital fund drives and membership dues
helped finance the origin of the
Corporation locally.

Revolving Loan Fund OPASOIS & SON

Our revolving loan fund comprises unencumbered funds available for building acquisition or renovation within the Pottsville Strategic Redevelopment Area. Upon meeting eligible criteria, applicants can be awarded up to \$100,000 for a maximum term of 5 years at a fixed interest rate. By dispersing \$1.4 million, which has leveraged over 3 million over the last 5 years, over 2 dozen local businesses and nonprofits have utilized this fund to acquire and improve buildings in Schuylkill County

Upper Floor Development

PADCO and Tamaqua Area
Community Partnership along with
Senator Dave Argall's Office present
an initiative to increase upper floor
occupancy in downtown Pottsville and
downtown Tamaqua. The ultimate goal
of this project is to further the
revitalization of Downtown Pottsville
and Downtown Tamaqua expanding
downtown livability by increasing
Upper floor occupancy in the
downtown areas. Pre-applications
require a selected property, the
planned number of units, and
expected financing plans



Community Initiative Grant



PADCO and the Pottsville Redevelopment Authority have partnered to create a Community Initiative Façade Grant to aid beautification projects within the Strategic Development Area. Grant is available for up to five projects up to \$25,000 within the defined area. This grant will match two-thirds of the total project cost, with up to \$10,000 provided by the applicant. Applicants are expected to provide the necessary information about the property, ownership, and details of the project including estimates, schematics, drawings, or other necessary information
